Tom Wheeler is President and CEO of the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association (CTIA), a position he has held since 1992. For two decades Mr. Wheeler has worked at the forefront of telecommunications policy and technology.

As a telecommunications entrepreneur, Mr. Wheeler founded or helped start multiple companies offering new cable, wireless and video communications services, both domestically and internationally.

From 1976 to 1984, Mr. Wheeler was associated with the National Cable Television Association (NCTA), where he was president from 1979 to 1984.

President Clinton and President Bush appointed Mr. Wheeler to the Board of Trustees of the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts. He is also President of the Foundation for the National Archives, and a director of Tech Corps and the Public Broadcasting Service (PBS). Mr. Wheeler is the author of *Take Command! Leadership Lessons from the Civil War*, published by Doubleday.

Mr. Wheeler is a graduate of Ohio State University and resides in Washington, D.C. with his wife and two children.
